Composition

99% Cabernet Sauvignon, 1% Cabernet Franc

Vineyards

Italics Estate Vineyard, Coombsville

Fermentation

The grapes were hand-picked, double-sorted, then gently crushed and fermented in a combination of stainless steel and French oak. The must underwent a relatively long threeweek maceration to extract added flavor, aroma and color compounds. The wine was then transferred to French oak barrels for aging.

Aging

24 months in French oak barrels, 75% new, 25% neutral

Alcohol

14.5%

The first vintage of our Estate Cabernet
Sauvignon offers aromas of plum, black currant
and pomegranate which give way to black
licorice and cocoa powder that are a signature
of the AVA. With a rich mouthfeel and polished
tannins, it can be consumed alone, but will stand
up to the most robust meals.
