## Viticulture

The 2014 Italics Estate Cabernet Sauvignon was created from blocks of old-vine estate Cabernet Sauvignon, planted with Napa's tried and true clones. And in 2014, we harvested the first crop of our newer blocks, planted with some heirloom clones.

## Aging

24 months in French oak barrels, 75% new, 25% neutral

**Alcohol** 14.5%

Production 1270 cases

## **Tasting Notes**

The nose is sweet, like smelling a sugar glaze as it is drizzled on a warm spice cake. In the mouth, the texture is like a perfectly brewed cup of Assam tea – warm and just enough tannin to give the palate length and duration. This is not a heavy, chewy wine. On the contrary, it is built for lasting pleasure.
