Tasting Notes

The 2015 Italics Proprietary Red Wine opens with cassis and raspberries. The mid-palate is rich and creamy, tempered by a fruit-based acidity. The mouthfeel has a graphite texture, intermingling with the mid-palate and delivering length and density to the finish. As a Bordeaux blend, it combines the softness of Merlot with the intensity of Cabernet Sauvignon, and seasoned with trace amounts of Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc to give it layers of fruit and complexity. This wine will exceed your expectations, opening up beautifully, and delighting your senses. We sell out of this wine early, and it's obvious why.
